



# Appel pour l'interdiction des Pesticides Extrêmement Dangereux

**Des décennies d'expériences** ont montré qu'en dépit des nombreux programmes d'«utilisation sécuritaire», «l'utilisation sécuritaire» des Pesticides Extrêmement Dangereux (HHPs) n'est pas possible. Les Hommes, les animaux domestiques, la faune et l'environnement continuent de subir d'importants préjudices provoqués par les Pesticides Extrêmement Dangereux (HHP). Après des décennies d'échecs qui ont vu des millions de morts dans le monde, de nouvelles politiques sont nécessaires pour stopper les intoxications par les pesticides. L'élimination progressive et l'interdiction des Pesticides Extrêmement Dangereux, accompagnées de nouvelles politiques en faveur des alternatives, peuvent apporter des changements vers un monde sain et durable pour tous.
